EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

DESCRIPTION OF SERVICES PROVIDED BY THE GARBAGE DISTRICT

The Garbage Collection District provides for the collection, transportation and delivery of solid waste materials. The Garbage Collection District provides for the collection of designated recyclable materials and used newspapers from curbside, provides pickup and transportation of stock piles of leaves and leaf matter to a composting facility and the payment of garbage tipping fees.

CONTRACTUAL SERVICES

A. Joseph Smentkowski, Inc.

The contract period is a five-year contract beginning January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2018 for the collection, transportation and delivery of solid waste material. The five-year contract was awarded for \$1,909,530.00.

B. Caputo Brothers Tree Service, Inc.

The contract is a two-year contract for the loading, transportation and disposal of leaves. The two-year contract was awarded for \$4.25 per cubic yard.

C. First Occupational (FORWI) of Orange

The Contract is a three-year contract beginning November 1, 2011 to October 31, 2014 for curbside collection of recyclable materials. The three-year contract was awarded in the amount of \$380,000.
